You can leave this field empty. This is an order number that we (and every other operator in AT) assign to each porting. "P" stands for porting, and "65" is Colt's identifier (each operator in Austria has a 2-digit identifier). Most clients who port numbers frequently have created their own order number which needs to be formed of 7 digits (numbers and letters), eg.: P65/AR00213, and they keep track of them. But we also have many clients who don't have their own order numbers, so we assign them one of ours, so you do not need to fill it in.

Einzelanschluß is basically a single number, so a private line/a single line.
ISDN Basisanschluß (Primary Rate Interface PRI) is the basic ISDN connection and can come with several MSN-Nummern. The MSNs (Multiple Subscriber Numbers) cannot be ported without their "global/main number", their basic connection. The basic connection can be ported without its MSNs, but once that's done, those MSNs don't exist anymore and cannot be ported. This is really important, MSNs must always be ported together with the Global Number.
ISDN Multianschluß (Primary Rate Interface) is another type of ISDN connection which offers 30 channels.
